The 4-day course plus completion of the exam and practicum qualify for **52 CE Hours** for nurses, **56 CE Hours** for massage therapist and PDHs for Child Life Specialists and **5 CEUs** for Occupational Therapist through AOTA Provider number 6015

Infant massage is a parent education program based on family strengths that promotes the physical and emotional well-being of babies and young children. Infant massage has many positive benefits that can help encourage secure attachment, bonding and communication between parent and baby and facilitate long term positive emotional development.

As a CEIM you help parents use nurturing touch to feel closer to their babies, reduce baby's colic and fussing, and become healthier and happier.
